ESTIMATED TIME COMMITMENT:

Time commitment is flexible depending on availability and could vary from several, to many hours a month. Workload would definitely be busier during the summer months of June - August where the HP squad is actively training and competing.

It is possible that it could take up to 2 hours for the recording and analysis of stats for a single game (travel time not included)

Some teaching time may be required so that the stat taker is aware of what form the coach would like the stats to take. During a tournament where a number of GCBVC teams are playing, stats on up to 4 or 5 games a day may be required.

JOB DESCRIPTION:

Activity would involve taking statistics during games either on paper or computer programme then analysing and presenting findings to the appropriate coaches.

The job could extend to travelling away with teams to events out of state.

It is possible with modern technology that this job could be done remotly through live video feed of games using the periscope app.

OBJECTIVE / OUTCOME:

Statistics will aid coaches in their coaching of players and stats will also allow players to be aware of what they are doing well or not so well. Overall, stats will help our athletes be more successful.

SKILLS REQUIRED:

- A brain for numbers may help but is not vital.
- A basic understanding of the game.
- Good eyesight
